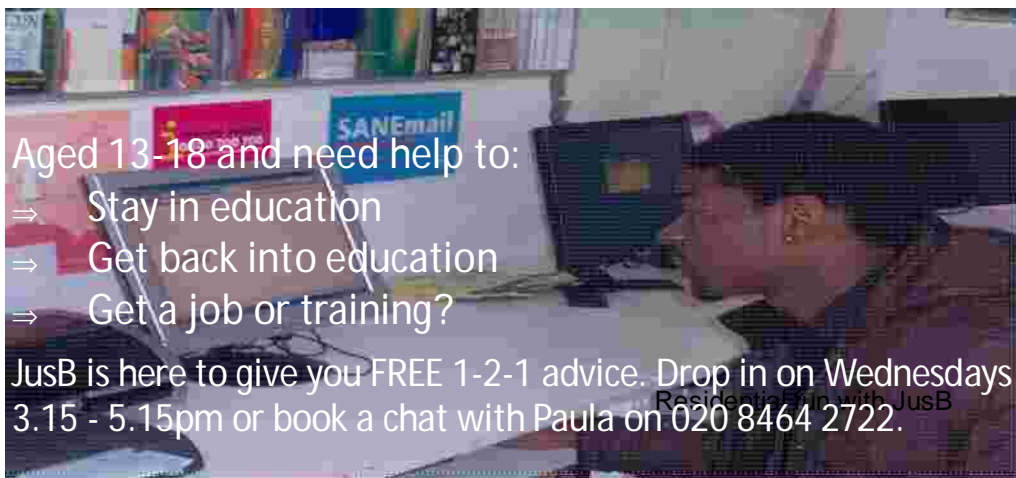
What is JusB?
