Here we ask the young people why they think JusB is worth fighting for:

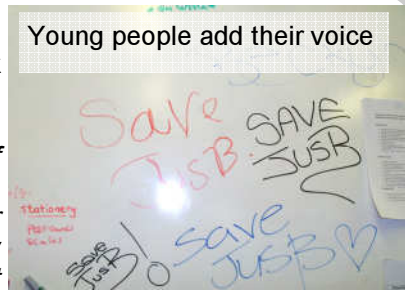
*'I came to JusB because I have been out of education for two years, JusB has helped me get back into it and set up 1 to 1 tutoring for me. The youth club has made me build up my confidence. I would be lost if JusB got shut down because it keeps us off the street.'*

*'I've been coming to JusB for about a year or so and it has helped me in many different ways, like workshops about healthy eating and relationships. If I weren't attending JusB I would probably be on the streets, making trouble with people. So far JusB has had a good impact on my life, but not just mine, it helps everyone who attends in all sorts of different ways.'*

*'I have been coming to JusB for two years. I come to JusB to get off the streets so that I am safe and looked after.'*

*'JusB is very welcoming and (they) are helping me to get a college placement.'*

*'We love JusB and if it closed down we will be the ones that lose out.'*
